OWNERSHIP

2023 TERM 1 START DATE

Next year we will trial starting school on the **7th of February** after Waitangi Day so that we finish school closer to Christmas.

Staff will be having a teacher-only-day on the 31st of January with staff from all our Kahui Ako Schools. We will also have our own teacher-only-day on the 1st of February with some professional development in an area to be determined. The whole school year Term dates for 2023 will be shared with families towards the end of the term.

TEACHERS IN 2023

We have now determined our staffing and class levels for 2023. We have high numbers in some year groups, so we need to split these so that we have low teacher:student ratios across all classes. This process takes a while as we work out the best placement for each student.

Our Board of Trustees are providing some funding towards our 7th teacher for the third year running.

PAID UNION MEETINGS (PUM'S) - WED 16 NOV

Our teachers are in contract negotiations with their union and the Ministry of Education. Over the last few days the Ministry have presented teachers with an offer which they now need to either accept or reject. In the afternoon of

Wednesday 16 November, our staff will attend a paid union meeting at the Te Awamutu Intermediate with teachers from the Waipa District.

We will have a skeleton staff with myself and our Teacher Aides looking after the students from 1pm onwards. You are most welcome to collect your child/children from school from 1pm onwards if you like. Buses will be running after school.

TEACHER ONLY DAY REMINDER - 5th DECEMBER

At our last staff meeting, our teachers received the first part of their professional development in the Digital Curriculum.

The next part to this is a whole day on the 5th of December. Our school will be closed for instruction on this day.

BUILDING PROJECTS UPDATE

Since our last newsletter, our new school alarm system has been installed.

Our deck is nearing completion with steps starting tomorrow.

The first of our 3 stacker doors has been installed in Rimu class with painters/plasterers working in this room.

Underfloor installation will be happening over the next 2 weeks and our new fire alarm system will be installed within this timeframe as well.

Rimu students have moved into our school library this week with a return to class one day next week. Thanks Mrs Hammond-Tutty for organising your students to move into the library at late notice.



2023 DONATION SCHEME

From January 2023, the new Equity Index (EQI) will be used to determine eligibility for the School Donations Scheme. This scheme replaces the old decile rating system. The threshold for eligibility is an EQI number **432**. Kio Kio School's EQI number is **468**, so we have been advised by the Ministry of Education that we are now eligible to opt-in-to this scheme.

In the past we have asked for a donation of \$90 per child, which goes towards school resources. If we decide to accept the opt-in option, then this donation will cease. The Ministry will give us **\$154.13 (excluding GST) per student per year**.

We will receive this amount if we agree **not** to ask parents and caregivers for donations, except for overnight camps. This initiative is designed to alleviate pressure and expectation on parents and whānau to provide donations.

Could you please contact me at school if you are against us accepting this new donation scheme.

Personally, I view this as a positive step moving forward.

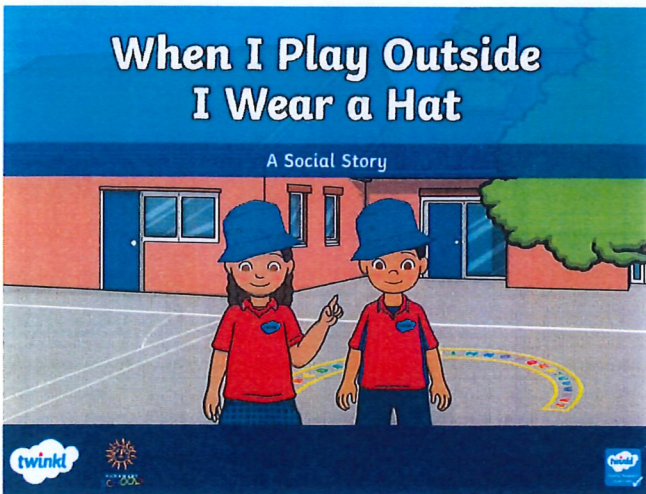
