At present we have **coughs, colds, tummy bugs, headaches** etc still making their rounds at school. If your child/children are sick, please keep them at home until better and notify the school office

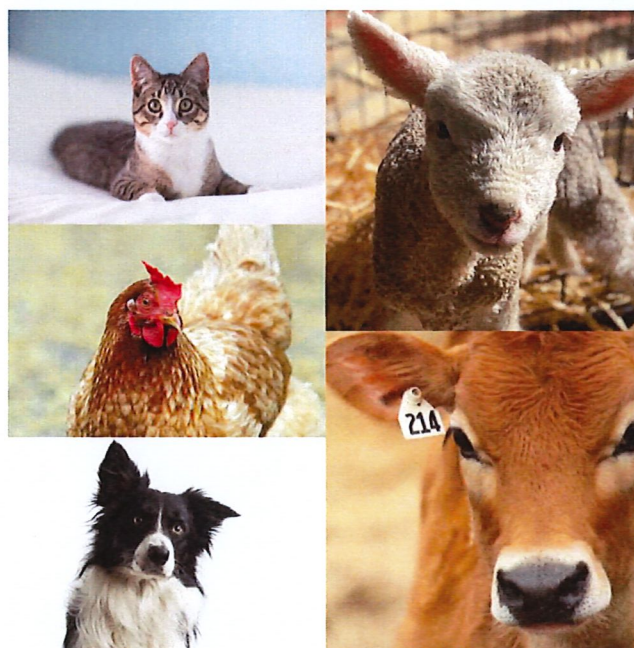
of their absence, so we can mark accordingly for the Ministry of Education.

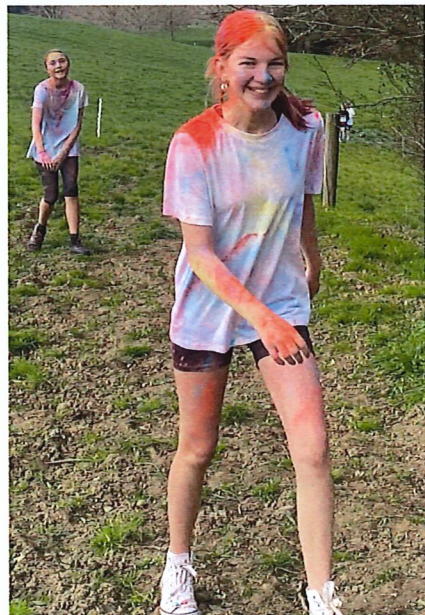

This year Kio Kio School will be running a 'donate a calf' or the 'proceeds of a cull cow' fundraiser.

All proceeds will go towards teaching & learning resources



### CALVES

This fundraiser is where we ask farmers to donate and rear a calf for the school.

The calf can be either a:

- Jersey Bull
- Friesian Bull
- Angus Bull
- Hereford Cross Bull
- Jersey/Friesian Cross Bull

The calves will be collected in early November and on sold. They must be NAIT registered and 100kg

### CULL COWS

Rearing a calf may not be a feasible option for you but donating the proceeds of a cull cow may suit you better. This can happen at any time that suits you and your farming operation. Or done through Silver Fern Farms, by nominating our school.
